

BOULDERING AREAS

Murrin Park Area – Quality, angular blocks in the forest around Browning Lake.

Shannon Falls – Unique, water-worn boulders in an aesthetic setting near the falls along with scattered blocks of very high quality in the forest to the south.

Grand Wall – The business. The biggest and most popular area in this book.

Apron Boulders – An extension of the Grand Wall area that's out in the open and more talus-like. Dries very fast.

The North Walls – Many excellent and varied areas of high density spread along the Mamquam River Forest Service Road on the north side of the Chief. Forested bouldering as good as the Grand Wall.

Crumpit Woods – Three bouldering areas off Powerhouse Springs Road behind Valleycliffe, all with a different flavour. Swamp Thing is as roadside as it gets.

Smoke Bluffs – This municipal park is the most popular roped climbing area in Canada. It has some good bouldering, too.

Garibaldi – Small bouldering areas scattered around the north end of town. Biker Boulders is the most substantial.

Powerline Boulders – Forest and talus bouldering. The Emerging Dream boulder is huge and features athletic problems.

Cat Lake – Open, talus-field bouldering on stone similar to Paradise Valley.

Paradise Valley – Remote and pristine. Top-quality stone in a sensitive area near the Tenderfoot Creek Hatchery.
