# **Punny Wall**



**Access/notes:** From Highway 99, go up the Conroy Forest Service Road and take a left at the small middle parking lot. Keep going down the road for about a minute and you'll see a large crag on your right, opposite to the campsites. Near the Ursa Minor/Kaiju Bear/Andre's Wall areas.

The area gets sun in the morning and shade in the afternoon. Ideal for sunny summer days. The routes are generously bolted.

From left to right:

### 1. Mt. Snuggles - 5.8 - 29 metres - 16 bolts

Climb the right facing corner at the base of the crag. Thoughtful face climbing leads into a short crack with hand and finger jams. Then up a featured blocky section until finishing with a very low angle slab. With the amount of bolting, it's not a struggle — it's a snuggle!

#### 2. The MinoriTeam - 5.9 - 26 metres - 11 bolts

Leftmost climb on the main ledge. Access the start via CyberCuck (pull rope). Starts up a left-trending seam, then to a big ledge rest. This is the start of the trickiest section. Navigate this by finding a hidden jug, then, a few moves later, a hidden side-pull to the right.

#### 3. Obvious Line - 5.10 - 26 metres - 14 bolts

Also on the main ledge. Access the start via CyberCuck (pullrope). To the right of The MinoriTeam. Climb the obvious line. Tricky start leads to a jug haul. Caps off with a high mantle.

## 4. CyberCuck - 5.0 - Fixed line, bolts

The way to access routes on the main ledge. Climb the fixed line with an option to clip the bolts. It's a real climb, we swear!
