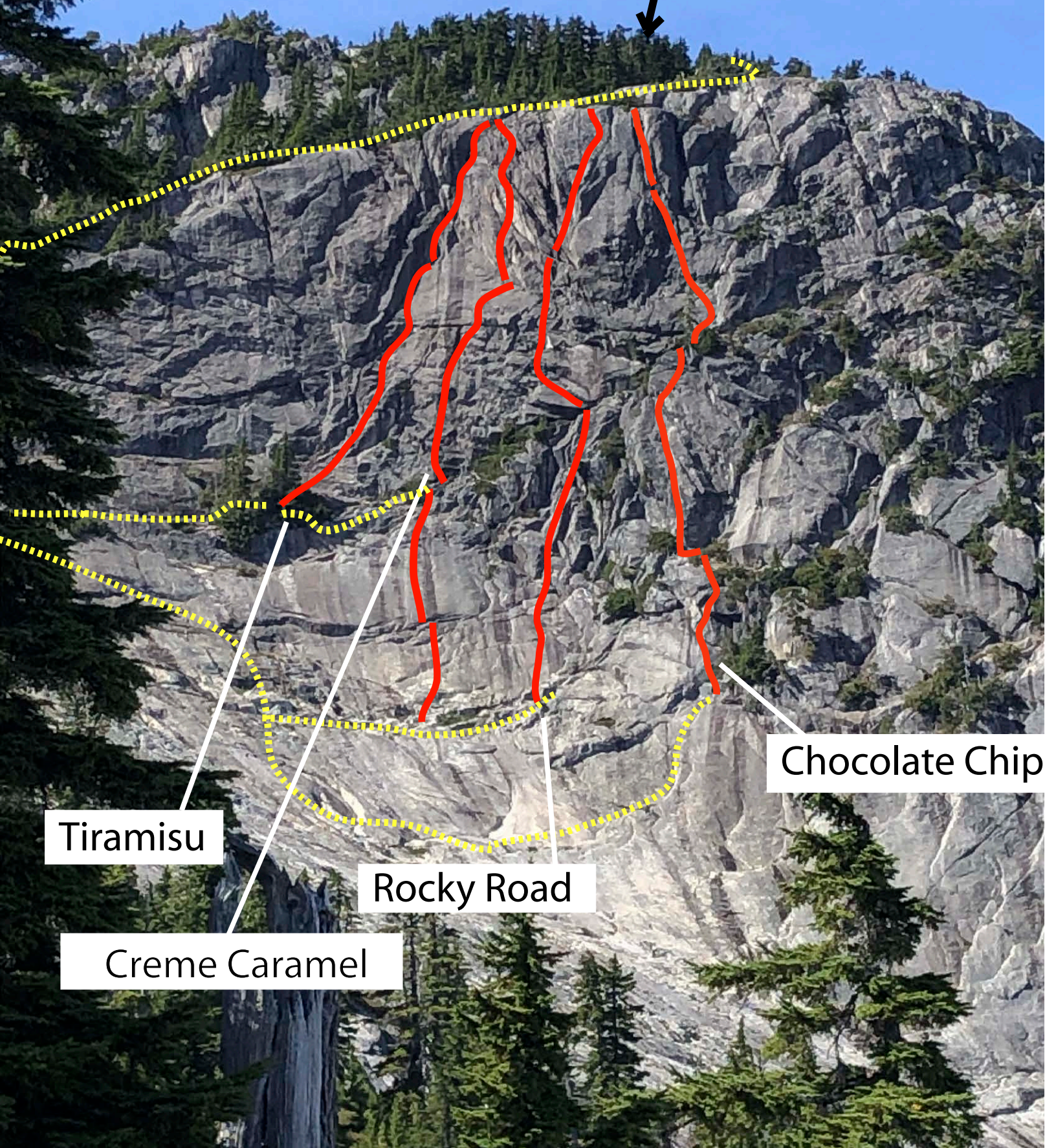


# The Big Scoop Wall

# Big Scoop Wall

Four high quality routes in an alpine setting

Bolted stations, Single rack to 4" double cams from 1" to 4", 15 draws/ extendable slings, 70 m rope recommend

## Location:

East face of summit above Sea to sky Gondola.

## Getting there:

Access via Al s Habrich trail to Robins' connector ,1.5 hours Just before summit drop down to the left to overlook above the wall (clear view of Mt. Habrich to the east). The four routes all top out and an obvious flat bushy terrace just below an open slabby area. To access the base rap Cookies and Cream or walk down ramp to the south, cutting back to the north at the top of the "Big Scoop"

## Tiramisu (10b)

Two pitches, 5.10b

Access obvious large uppermost treed ledge that cuts across the main wall from the left side, at its end pull up above the large trees. Route climbs the prominent right leaning crack/ corner system to the top In two pitches of 35m and 30m . Bolted stations. FA 2019 Glenn Woloski, Robin Barley

## Crème Caramel (10d)

Start at second horizontal fault, a broad sandy ledge cutting across lower wall where the angle eases off. A single bolt in a small corner below the dark streak marks the start. (Possible to Traverse 20m right from start of Tiramisu tree pod ,with one bolt to station .missing pitch one)

P1 (55m, 5.9) Climb face with three bolts and some gear left of dark streak. Continue up easily to station at base of dark streak on main wall 55m 5.9

P2 (35 m, 10d) climb steeply on jugs ,cracks and a bit of slab for 35m 10d

P3 (30 m, 10c) Up steeply again though a Fist /hand crack ,up through overlapping rib features then trending left to top anchor . 25m 10c 2023 Glenn Woloski, Harry Young

## Rocky Road (10b)

Start of route from the end of sandy vegetated ledge as for crème caramel single bolt marks the start of first pitch

P1 (50m 5.8) Climb right facing corners through overlap then right, up steep blocks and cracks to large ledge

P2 (25m, 5.9) Undercling out left passing one bolt . Arc upwards towards obvious white scar and another bolt.

Continue up to bolted station

P3 (25m, 10b) Climb out right steeply past a bolt and up on more of the same above on good holds ,bolts and gear where you can get it. FA 2023 Glenn Woloski, Harry Young

## Chocolate Chip (10a)

Start on the lower part of the 'scoop' on a smaller horizontal fault line making your way up the a bushy corner with a leaning dead tree. A single bolt marks the start.

P1 Climb slab to steepish rocky headwall and climb up tending right past a single bolt to gain the large slanting terrace , station at headwall

P2 (25 m, 10b) Move left and around to climb a long left facing corner Transfer up right at the top passing a few bolts on a wider face, top out on the ledge

P3-4 (40m, 10a) Start out right on face and climb though bolts to gain steep featured wall and twin cracks two 20 m pitches or link together. FA 2021 Glenn Woloski, Harry Young, Yuko Iwanaga
