

Blood Moon - 13a

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Micro cams, small nuts, triple .3, .4, .5,
double .75 and #1, single #2 and #3



Five pitches of high quality crack climbing. North facing and high up, a good option for avoiding the summer heat. From Polar Dome walk left along Toad Hall Ledge then make two thirty meter rappels from bolted stations to access the base.

1. 5.12b burly steep crack climbing. Start near the arete and trend right hand traversing the flake to reach the crack in the shallow left facing corner.
2. 5.13- The tips splitter that you came for. Place good thin gear and punch it to the top.
3. 5.12a Move the belay left and climb the left of two splitter hands roof cracks.
4. 5.9R Easy but runout slab climbing to the base of the steep headwall.
5. 5.12+ More sustained steep crack climbing, save some juice for the top!
6. Continue up ~180m of rambling 5.7 to the summit of Habrich. Descend down the West face/Escape Velocity.

Protection: Micro cams, small offset cams, small nuts, triple .3, .4 and .5, double .75 and 1, single 2 and 3.
