

SQUAMISH SELECT – Fifth edition updates posted August 31st, 2026

Shannon Falls

The Curmudgeon (10- R) On Mt Habrich. This multi-pitch route is found right of the start of Goldilocks Zone. Look for the topo on the Free Topos page of the website.

The Malamute

Cling Peaches Var (10b) This variation is found to the left of the start of the original corner crack of *Cling Peaches*. It's on the face and follows a curving shallow crack past a few bolts. FA Brendan Baggio, 2026.

Shanay

Solitary Beats (12b) At the Top Shelf. Start on *Townsend's Solitaire* and layback/undercling the arch out right to join *Ectopic Beats*. FA Ryan Laroque, 2026.

El Patron (11b) At the Top Shelf. The direct finish to Perseverance with a small yet safe runout above bomber gear at the top. FA Colin Moorhead, 2026.

Blueberry Canyon This new crag is found below the backside road to the gondola, not long beyond Golden Gate. Look for the topo on the Free Topos page of the website.

Crumpit Woods

Right of Way (11a) At Fern Hill. Start just right of *Golden Redemption* and follow chains trending leftward. Cross leftward through *Golden Redemption* at the midway slab and then finish through a roof above the anchors of *Yellow Fever*. *Right of Way* links well into the top of *Golden Redemption* at a moderate 10b. FA Kris Wild, 2026.

Little Tree (11a) At Fern Hill. In the guidebook, the text for *Feigned Indignation* reads "Little Tree breaks right at bolt four". This is incorrect. The original line of Little Tree breaks left and climbs part of *Binding Spell*, but since the *Little Tree* anchor is gone, the route is now pretty much defunct.

The Sound of Money (11b) At Yonderland. Climb direct though bulges to an airy finish between *Grizelda's Flake* and *OK Deary*. FA Nigel Slater, 2026.

Paradise Valley

Geogaddi (14b/c) Climb *Kype of the Pinook* until it's possible to move rightward across the steep wall to finish at the top of *The B-Side*. FA Ben Harnden, 2026.

Spirit in the Sky (14b) This link-up climbs *Spirit Quest* until it's possible to move left above the opening crux of *Queen Bee*. From here, finish on *B-Side*. FA Ben Harnden, 2026.

Spirit Way (14c) This link-up climbs the start of *Spirit of the West* into *Midnight Way*. FA Mike Foley, 2026.

Smoke Bluffs

Inexorably Senile (5.11a) At the Smoke Bluff Wall. The original grade is 10c, but it's been suggested that it's more like 11-.

Cowardly Lion (5.11d) At the Smoke Bluff Wall. This pitch breaks off Wonderland just before the final leftward horizontal crack traverse. FA Tony McLane, 2026.

Yankee Colonizers (5.8) At Neat and Cool. The name has been changed from the original “No Yankee Colonizers”.

Brohm Lake Area

Lasagna Wall This new crag in the trees north of Brohm Lake features a few climbs. Look for the topo on the Free Topos page of the website.

Road Rage This new cragging area is in the trees above the east side of Highway 99. Look for the topo on the Free Topos page of the website.

Cheakamus Canyon

Hot Salad (10c) At Paradise Alley. Climbs the line of Project #45 in the text. FA Alex Ryan Tucker, 2026.

The Last Straw (13a) At Office Space. The left-most line at the crag, just left of Where's the Motivation. FA Remy Laroque, 2026.

Phantom Menace (5.9) At the Sport Temple. The text indicates that both pitches can be combined at 25 m, but this link-up is actually over 35 m long. This is useful to know when descending, since a 70-m rope comes up a bit short for the final rappel.

Cardinal Sin (12c) At the Monastery. This is the project left of *Friar Power* that finishes up and to the left. FA Graham McGrenere, 2026. **Cardinal Power** (12c) links the first third of *Cardinal Sin* into the upper half of *Friar Power*. It features two distinct boulder problems separated by a very good rest. FA Spencer Arbuckle, 2026.

Salmon Handcuffs (13b) At the Monastery. The straight up extension to *Golden Handcuffs*. FA Remy Laroque, 2026.

Adult Summer Camp (10b) At the Foundation Wall. Currently the right-most route at the crag. FA The Mountaineers and Squamish Rock Guides, 2026.

Resurrection (13b) At Central Chek. To find this pitch, continue hiking down-canyon from the Main Event/Big Show area, passing the turn off that leads up to Echo Beach. A bit of bushwhacking (5-10 minutes) leads to this wall, which is on the right side of the valley. This is currently the only route on the wall and is reportedly good *and* very steep. Bring knee pads.

The Empire Strikes Back (13d) At the Gorge. Climb the steep face (13+) right of *Eugenics War* pitch one and, without stopping, continue up *Kling On* for a long, 45-metre journey of wild face climbing. FA Stu Smith, 2026.
